From the beginning the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic sacrifice, so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God.” (1031-1032) Let us pray for those who have died. **A Book of Remembrance will be available near the baptismal font at St. Francis and by the stairs, at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel,** where you may enter names that will then be prayed for at mass during November.
