14th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jesus states, in our Gospel this weekend, "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light." (Matthew 11:28-30)

The above may likely be familiar scripture that you have heard before and that sounds familiar. Below are some of my thoughts and reflections:

"Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest." Applying to our times, in my mind, these words of Jesus convey that God wants to help us have less worry and more trust. That God will help carry the load in that we do not need to go it alone, that Jesus sees the labor and burden of the fallen world and invites us to a relationship with him that will be of help and provide rest for us.

"Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, ... In reflecting on this part, I come to think about that it is not a matter if we have a "yoke" but what "yoke" it will be. Whether it is the yoke of Jesus or in contrast the yoke we think we want, or the yoke of the world, or the yoke of the enemy. There will always be a "yoke", the question being which yoke.

"... for I am meek and humble of heart; ... Jesus tells us he is "meek and humble of heart". To me, I think about that Jesus wants our good and is patient with us. His heart loves and desires our good, it is a humble heart of a good master. He is the master, there is a yoke, but a good master that we "learn" from and loves us. When we take our own yoke, or the yoke of the world or the yoke of the enemy, means a yoke of a cruel master. A cruel master leading one down the wrong path, that will not be for our good. A yoke that is not of God, I think leads in the end to discouragement, disillusionment and despair.

"...and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light." The yoke of Jesus, following him will help and lead to inner peace in this world and lasting peace in heaven. In contrast, the yoke of the enemy, for example, leads to self-hatred and despair. The yoke of Jesus demands that we follow him, follow his words, teaching, His Church, etc., but his yoke, his path, leads to peace and eternal rest.

The above are some ways to consider the scripture we have this weekend. I invite you to take some time in prayer with this scripture seeking the "yoke" of Jesus.
