OLMC

The feast day of Our Lady of Mount Carmel is July 16th in the Church calendar. Even though it falls on a Sunday this year, because Our Lady of Mount Carmel is the patroness of our parish, the feast day can be celebrated in place of the 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time. It will be good to do so on a weekend, we don't often have that option.

In the 1200's, hermits lived on Mount Carmel, in the holy land, legend being with a particular devotion to Our Lady. Through war at that time, they fled Mount Carmel, but were able to continue and out of this the religious order began to form, the Carmelites, tracing their origins to Mount Carmel.

Tradition holds that Our Lady appeared to St. Simon Stock, a Carmelite priest in England in 1251. That Our Lady had with her a scapular, and would provide her protection for those wearing a scapular. Thus, the scapular reflects devotion to Our Lady and seeking her protection.

St. Francis History

By Madelyn Rice: "This is just a story about the Ku Klux Klan that is part of our family history. My grandparents, John and Mary Connelly, and their ten children lived a few miles northeast of Neligh. One summer night the family awoke to laughter and men on horses in



the front yard. Soon a fiery cross was burning. The four men on horses [dressed in Klan robes and hoods] made lots of noise and rode away. One of the horses was a beautiful black. As soon as the riders left, Grandpa, being a wild Irishman with a temper to match, jumped on a horse and with his shotgun across his lap rode to the nearest neighbor, who had a beautiful black horse..." (to be continued in the history!) Will include history of the KKK in this area with items from the newspapers reporting the various public gatherings of Klan members in Oakdale and Neligh in the 1920s.
