## Greetings from Fr. Pat

### St. Francis - Ambry

We recently had a small cabinet installed in the church at St. Francis. You may have been wondering what it is for? It holds the holy oils used in sacraments, and it is called an ambry.

Each year at the Chrism Mass during Holy Week, Archbishop Lucas blesses new oils to be used throughout the Archdiocese. This year the Chrism Mass is on March 25<sup>th</sup>. I then bring some of each of the oils back from this Mass to the parish to use during the year until Holy Week next year.



There are three different oils, as described: Oil of the Infirm or Sick (OI), Oil of Catechumens (OS), and Sacred Chrism (SC). The Oil of the Infirm is used, as you may guess, in

the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. The Oil of Catechumens is used in the sacrament of Baptism. Sacred Chrism is used in the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation (and for Holy Orders by the Archbishop). The containers that hold the oils are often marked with the abbreviations OI, OS, and SC. After March 25<sup>th</sup>, I will put the oils in the ambry for display. Students at Neligh-Oakdale from Brett Arehart's shop class built and installed the ambry.
