PALM SUNDAY



The tradition of veiling religious images is often practiced during the last two weeks of Lent, starting on the Fifth Sunday and ending on Good Friday. This two-week time period was known on the old liturgical calendar as "Passiontide." Even though it is no longer officially called by this name, the tradition is still practiced in many places.

The holy images are again revealed for Easter to mark the end of the penitential season. The joy of the Easter season and the hope of the Resurrection then comes to the forefront.

The old custom of veiling religious images is a way of focusing on the penitential aspect of this season. It reminds us in a visual way that our faith in all its glory is made possible only through the work of Christ in his suffering and death on the cross. When we cover these sacred images that we are so accustomed to, we are reminded of all that Christ has won for us.

Temporarily veiling the crosses and religious images in the penitential color of Lent is a beautiful custom that helps us to reflect on the deeper theological meaning of the liturgical season.
